(March 7, 2019) Ventura, Calif. -- A unique house-warming party will take place at The City Center of Ventura County (TCC) on Thursday, March 7, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. TCC, which operates a downtown Ventura homeless transitional housing facility, will host a room dedication and ribbon cutting ceremony to thank local sponsors who have contributed to the renovation and redesign of living accommodations for City Center residents.

The City Center is Ventura's only transitional housing center that does not receive government funding. TCC offers housing to the homeless, with a goal of transitioning clients out within a year. While living in TCC's residential units clients can concentrate on getting their lives under control, seek employment and obtain job skills to get back on their feet so they can move out into their own living situations.
